

Wife, mother, convert, foundress, educator, spiritual leader, and servant to the poor—Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton is a Saint for our times.

At the National Shrine of Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton, we invite you to walk in her footsteps, and join her legacy of prayer in the Basilica where she is entombed.

Mother Seton understood the joys and sorrows of life and knew well the power of prayer in helping loved ones. She frequently prayed for those dear to her. As a mother she prayed for the safety of her sons away at sea; as a wife, she prayed for the health of her husband; as a spiritual leader, she prayed for the welfare of the religious community she founded.



Since 1968, Elizabeth Ann Seton's sacred remains have been reposed here in a small copper casket behind the marble slab bearing her name. The statue is sculpted of Italian marble and depicts the habit worn by the Sisters of Charity of St. Joseph's.

Near the altar rest the written prayer requests of visitors and benefactors. A book near the altar contains over fifty thousand names of those enrolled in the Seton Shrine's Annual Mass Enrollment Society.
